Subject: MEDIA ADVISORY: Ontario appeal of stage 2 ruling of Robinson-Huron Annuities Case set to begin June 1

**Toronto** — On Tuesday, June 1 to Thursday, June 3 the Ontario Court of Appeal will hear the Ontario appeal of the Stage 2 decision regarding the Robinson-Huron Treaty Annuities Case. The 21 beneficiary First Nations of the Robinson-Huron Treaty are committed to continuing to hold the Crown accountable to their Treaty responsibilities through this appeal.

The Government of Ontario has appealed the Stage 2 decision, which found that the First Nation plaintiffs' claims are not barred by Ontario's limitations legislation and that Ontario does not benefit from the doctrine of Crown immunity. Canada has not appealed the Stage 2 decision.
