Ontario Court of Appeal Releases Judgement on Ontario's Stage 1 and 2 Appeals in Robinson Huron Treaty Annuities Case

Robinson Huron Treaty Territory — Representatives of the Robinson-Huron Treaty Litigation Fund welcome the judgment from the Court of Appeal released Friday that affirms much of the trial decision and only disagrees with the trial judgment on a limited number of issues.

The appeals were heard by five judges of the Court of Appeal which means that there are a number of specific reasons written by different members of the court. In the opening section of the decision the judgement states:

'The joint reasons provide the factual background to the case and summarize the court's conclusions on the issues arising in the appeals. As we explain, we unanimously reject the majority of the arguments raised on appeal. We dismiss Ontario's appeal from the Stage Two proceedings in its entirety ..."

Representatives of the Robinson-Huron Treaty Litigation Fund are holding a press conference to review the judgment and what it means for the 21 First Nations of the Robinson-Huron Treaty territory.
