



# Compensation Distribution Process

**The second pool of money is the \$232 million** which is the amount of legal fees Justice Fred Myers ordered the Legal Team to return to the Robinson Huron Treaty Litigation Fund (RHTLF). These funds, **plus \$16.2 million in interest**, are being disbursed in accordance with RHTLF's approved process.

Furthermore, it needs to be made clear that the funds will NOT be distributed directly to individuals/beneficiaries. The funds will be disbursed pursuant to the Compensation Disbursement Agreement (CDA) which is an agreement among the Robinson Huron Treaty (RHT) First Nations governing how funds are disbursed. This means that the funds will (*subject to holdbacks for the 5% Collective Set Aside Fund and 1% Living Annuitant Fund*) be given to the RHT First Nations which then will determine what to do with those funds.

## As per the CDA formula:

**\$232 million (returned legal fees) + \$16.2 million (interest) = \$248.2 million**



**55%**

Distributed to FNs who participated in the Trust, proportionate to respective populations



**39%**

Equally distributed to FNs that participated in the Trust



**5%**

Set aside for collective purposes of advancing rights and interests of all FNs who participated in the Trust



**1%**

Living annuitants who are not members of any of the FNs who participated in the Trust<sup>(+/-)</sup>

*<sup>(+/-)</sup> Any excess funds from the 1% will be distributed based on the formula to FNs who participated in the Trust. Any underfunded applicants, the FNs are to cover equally from the individual FN amount of distributions to be received from.*
