



# ***Did you know that the current settlement is for past compensation only?***

The settlement that was announced in June is for past dues that should have been paid over the last 170 years. In the Stage 1 trial, Justice Hennessy found the annuity was a collective amount owed to the Robinson Huron Treaty Anishinaabek. Our ancestors included the annuity clause in the Treaty to provide for future generations which is why this settlement will be distributed collectively - although there is a portion that will go to individual beneficiaries. The Crown will continue to distribute \$4.00 to beneficiaries until the next phase of negotiations are completed. In that phase, we will address issues like the sharing of future resources and revenues, and increasing the \$4/year annuity that individuals currently receive.
